



River Findhorn at Forres

**3.5km/2miles 2hrs**

## Short River Walk

A short circular walk along the banks of the Findhorn starting at the Garden Centre, crossing the River Findhorn at Broom of Moy and returning to the start via the Greshop area.

### The walk

This walk is marked with orange arrows. →

The walk starts from the car park of the Mackenzie & Cruikshank Garden Centre at the west end of the Greshop Industrial Estate, which itself is on the west side of Forres along the A96.

### BEWARE

The garden centre car park, which is fenced in, is open from 9.00am to 5.00pm Mon – Sat and 10.00am to 5.00pm Sunday. Outside these times the gate is locked.

Go through the small gate in the far corner of the car park, climb up the steps, leaving the wartime pillbox on your right. Turn left along the riverbank. Continue along the path and immediately after passing under the road bridge turn left up the bank and follow round until you come up to the footpath over the bridge. Cross over to the other side of the road, taking great care. Continue over the bridge and turn right before the bungalow. Walk down the steps to the river side.

Continue along this path until you meet the Bailey bridge, built by the Royal Engineers at the end of the Second World War, walk over the bridge and turn left along the tarmac track. After a few hundred yards, at the finger post, fork right. Follow this path, under the railway bridge (No. 59), and in Greshop Industrial Estate turn right into West Road. Follow this road then left into Greshop Road and on until you return to the garden centre.

If the garden centre is closed, start your walk from outside the fence. Follow the fence westwards and at its end turn sharp right up the short bank and join the riverside path. Then continue as above.
